CLASSROOM BEHAVIOR

Expectations:

Classroom behavior expectations will be dealt with in accordance with the CAMS student handbook/policies book.

CONSEQUENCES FOR BEHAVIOR ISSUES

Consequences for inappropriate behavior will be handled in the following manner.

- 1. Warning (Reinforce expectations)
- 2. A phone call home or a note about behavior will be sent home and a parent's signature will be required.
- 3. Removal from class and a phone call home.

CLASSROOM RULES

- 1. When you enter the band room you will set your chair and stand up and have 3 minutes to assemble your instrument, oil your valves, etc.
- 2. At the end of class you will place your chair and stand in its designated spot
- 3. There is to be no talking while I am teaching, look over your music, number your measures or write in your markings.
- 4. Food and drinks are not allowed in the band room. Only bottled water is permitted and it has to have a screw cap.
- 5. The band room is not a locker room or your own personal space to keep your personal belongings. All non-band related items (hats, shoes, magazines, cards etc.) will be disposed of immediately.
- 6. Students will not use fowl or harsh language.
- 7. Any violation of these classroom rules will result in a disciplinary action in accordance with CAMS handbook

ALL BRASS STUDENTS WILL NEED:

VALVE OIL

CLEANING MATERIALS (Mouthpiece brush polish towel)

ALL WOODWIND STUDENTS WILL NEED:

Cotton or silk cleaning swab

ALL CLARINET & SAXOPHONE STUDENTS:

At least 3 good working reeds at all times, at least 2.5 strength or higher.

ALL DOUBLE REED STUDENTS:

At least 3 good working reeds at all times.

ALL PERCUSSION STUDENTS:

A pair of Vic Firth snare sticks

SCHOOL OWNED INSTRUMENTS

There are some instruments available to rent with the school. There is a rental form available from Mr. English

INSTRUMENT IDENTIFICATION

All instruments should be identified in two ways:

- 1. On the outside of your case: Luggage tags or self-adhesive tags are very good for this purpose.
- 2. Inside your case with your name, address, phone number and parents

GRADING INFORMATION

All students will be graded on attendance 10%, class participation 10%, class preparedness 40%, playing tests, weekly practice and performance attendance 40%. All class work and specifics will be explained the first day of class and can be found in the syllabus.

Extra Credit Opportunities:

- 1. Participating in after school classes
 - a. A woodwind, percussion and brass class will be open to all students who want to advance their skills, participate in small ensembles, prepare for marching band or try a different instrument (with Mr. English's consent)
 - b. Extra credit will be applied each six weeks.
- 2. Attending live musical events:
 - a. Community band performances
 - b. Non rock shows
 - c. You must bring a program or ticket stub with you signed by your parents
- 3. If you are taking private lessons on your primary instrument.
 - a. I will need a written letter signed by your teacher

Course Description:
